

## BRIEFLY LEGAL AND COMMISSION NOTE Paying Commissions to LLCs and Happy Holidays

## **TODAY'S QUESTION**

Can a qualifying broker pay a salesperson's and associate broker's commission to their LLC?

## **THE ANSWER**

**Yes.** Section 34-27-36(a)(11) of License Law allows a salesperson or associate broker to own a lawfully constituted business organization, including but not limited to a corporation, limited liability company, or limited liability corporation for the purpose of receiving commissions. However, this business organization cannot engage in any licensed activity as defined in Section 34-27-30.
